

RVP7 V11 Release Notes

These notes cover changes made to the RVP7 code since release V10 of 21 August 1998. If you are upgrading from an earlier release, please read those notes also.

New Features

1. The support for intermediate minor releases of RVP7 code has been improved. The RVP7 now has a major version number (the one that it always had), plus a minor version number for intermediate "unofficial" releases. The minor number starts from zero at the time of each "official" release, and then increments until the next "official" release. The RVP7 now includes the minor release number (if it is not zero) in the printout of the "V" command. Likewise, the minor release number of the code that last saved the nonvolatile RAM is also shown. Previously, one had to rely on checking the date of the code to determine which minor release was being used.

The "official" Rev.11 release is therefore an exact copy of Rev.10, except that minor revision support has been added. Upcoming minor releases will, of course, be numbered "11.1", "11.2", etc.
